### Workshops

#### **Introduction to Sign-Supported Communication:**

Through interactive exercises, Accessible Arts & Media will demonstrate methods for communicating with people with disabilities, helping delegates to gain communication skills which can be applied in a range of situations, including Singing and Signing.

**Inclusive Music-Making Ideas:** An opportunity to try out musical activities and games to engage children and young people with SEND.
